

Changes in Biofuel Obligations 2025

The Department of Environment, Climate and Communications has announced an increase in the percentage of biofuel required in transport fuels, moving from 21% to 25%, which will affect your pricing from 1st January 2025 and will be added to Platts Assessments.

To meet the revised Government target of 25%, the industry requires the use of advanced biofuels in the product mix, and we will be adjusting the pricing calculations formula to facilitate such.

As biofuels trade at a premium to petrol and diesel, their inclusion at a greater rate means that the overall prices will increase.

To ensure the integrity of the fuel:

Where possible keep the tank full to reduce the build-up of water from condensation.

- Drain water from the tank on a regular basis.
- Empty and clean the tank every 5 years or earlier depending on the amount of water build up.
- Where fuel is stored for longer periods, the purchase of winter grade fuel is advised to ensure that the fuel does not wax in colder conditions.
